St Michael's CollegeVacation Care Booking Form and Booking Policy Agreement

St Michael's College are pleased to offer a vacation care service for the upcoming April school holidays.

Hours of Operation

Our operating hours for vacation care are 7am until 6pm.

Fees

Vacation care Normal days \$45.00.

Vacation care Excursion days \$55.00 Inclusive of attraction charge and transport with seat belts as standard.

Families from other schools are required to pay fees in full prior to attending care.

Late Fees

A late fee of \$15 for the first 15 minutes and then \$2 per minute thereafter will apply for children who are not collected by 6pm.

Bookings

The final date for bookings is Friday 6th April; this is to enable us to allocate sufficient staffing for each day of Vacation Care.

When bookings are taken the "Priority of Access Guidelines" set out by The Australian Government will be followed. They are as follows

When the demand for childcare exceeds supply (available places) in some locations, the following three levels of priority must be followed by childcare services;

- **Priority 1** A child at risk of serious abuse or neglect;
- **Priority 2** A child of a single parent who satisfies, or of parents who both satisfy, the work/training/ study test under section 14 of the A New Tax System (Family Assistance) Act 1999;
- **Priority 3** any other child.

Within these main categories, priority will also be given to the following children:

- children in Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander families;
- children in families which include a disabled person;
- children in families which include an individual whose adjusted taxable income does not exceed the lower income threshold, or who or whose partner are on income support;
- children in families from a non-English speaking background;
- children in socially isolated families;
- · children of single parents.



St Michael's College families receive priority for all vacancies and we will accept bookings for female siblings who are primary school age.

Cancellations

Cancellations for bookings must be made within 1 operating day of the booking. Excursion days may incur a full fee charge if children on the waiting list cannot fill a cancelled position; Absences without notifying the service will incur the full fee.

Clothing

To ensure that your child remains protected from harmful UV levels, children must wear sun smart clothing when in attendance.

Tops must cover the shoulder at all times.

Closed toe shoes must be worn at all times during care.

Cancer Council SA recommends wearing a broad brimmed, bucket or legionnaire hat as protection for the sun. Baseball caps do not provide adequate protection to the face, neck and ears, and are not recommended for wear.

Factor 50+ Sunscreen will be provided at the sign in desk for each child. It is the parental responsibility to apply sunscreen before they are signed in to the service. Staff will supervise the children re applying sunscreen at regular intervals throughout the day and this will be recorded onto the daily booking sheet for your viewing.

There may be times where a staff member will support the correct application of sun screen to arms, neck and face, but the priority is for us to model correct application and always ensuring the child is adequately protected.

Food

Breakfast and Afternoon Tea is provided everyday

Children will need to bring in lunch and morning recess unless specified on the activities sheet. Breakfast will be available between 7am and 08:30.

All foods served are nut free and support the National Healthy Eating guidelines.

Vegetarian alternatives and gluten free foods are available upon request.

Recess will be set at 10am and 3pm each day.

Personal Items

St Michael's College does not accept responsibility for lost or stolen personal items brought in from home.

Personal items such as mobile phones, MP3 players or toys and game cards are brought in at the child's own risk.

Most mobile phones now have the capacity to take photographs and record video. Children are not be allowed to use their personal equipment to take photographs or video of staff or other children whilst in vacation care.

Medication

A medication authority document is required from a doctor in order for OSHC staff to administer medication.

All medication must be in the original container, clearly labelled with the child's name legible, and a valid date.

Signing in and out

It is a legal requirement that a parent or notified adult must sign the children in and out of the program each day.

To ensure maximum safety and the duty of care for your child, please inform a staff member when you collect your child.

If children are to be collected by anyone other than those stated on the enrolment form, please send an email or call OSHC to inform us. We are unable to release children into the care of any unauthorised person.
