### Coronavirus (COVID -19) further update: Term 3 - 2021 – School Events/Activities

Yesterday at a press conference, the Premier of SA, the Honourable Steven Marshall, MP, announced a number of changes that impact schools. As a result, we provide you with updates to our communications dated 30 July 2021, in line with information and requirements we have received from SA Health and Catholic Education SA:

- Friday's Year 3 Cooking Program: will commence Friday, 20 August, students and staff only. A limited cooking program will proceed until such time as volunteers can return.
- Sacramental Program: information will be provided in due course.
- Friday, 13 August – Academic Awards & New Student Welcome Assembly\*, can resume, outlined as follows:  
*Mid-Year Intake, Reception & Year 1:* The event will be live streamed. One parent of each of our Lasallian Stars may attend (\*\*on this occasion we have made an exemption to 'visitors are not permitted on site'; as this is the start of our Lasallian Stars' school journey. Strict requirements will be in place). Families will receive a separate letter.  
*Year 2 to 6:* The event will be live streamed. Students and staff only.
- Incursions and excursions: can resume.
- 13-15 September – Year 6 Camp: This camp will proceed. Mr Nathan Rose, Primary Coordinator is planning the event. Information will be provided in due course.
- Co-curricular: can resume – you'll be advised about trainings and games, practices and performances by the relevant Specialist Teacher or Team Coaches.
- School Sports including interschool sport training, trials and competitions.

***\*Density and physical distancing requirements are to be met by all attending adults, please refer to the signage, or if you are unsure, please clarify with a member of staff\****  
**Protective face masks are required to be worn by all adults when on campus.**

The following outline communicated to you on 27 July 2021, remains in place:

### **Student Arrival**

Parents/Caregivers are asked to please avoid entering the school grounds when dropping off and collecting students, where possible. Please use the Kiss & Drop on Hubbard Street.

### **Student Departure**

At the end of the day, due to current space restrictions, class teachers will walk their students on to the oval. Parents may access the grounds to collect their child, however they must check in via the COVID-Safe QR code. Protective face masks are required to be worn by all adults when on campus.

### **Visitors & Volunteers**

Visitors and volunteers are not permitted on site at this time\*\*. However, should you need to enter the school grounds, please make your way to the Administration Centre and our Administration staff will assist you. Please adhere to the maximum capacity sign of people in our Administration Centre, according to current social distancing requirements. Visitors are required to check in via the COVID-Safe QR code and are to wear a protective face mask if they enter the Admin Centre.

### **College Staff Carpark**

Please do not use the College staff carpark for student morning drop off and afternoon pick up. The carpark should only be accessed by staff between 8.15-9am and 2.30-3.30pm. Should you have an appointment during these times with a staff member at the College, please use the designated visitors' carparks.

Should you need to drop off or collect your child during 9am and 3pm, there is a 10 minute loading zone on East Avenue.

As further restrictions are lifted, updates will be provided in a timely manner.
