TEACHING AND LEARNING DELIVERY (SECONDARY CAMPUS)

Dear Parents/Caregivers and Students

We are delighted to welcome the entire Year 7 to 12 cohort back to the campus and look forward to resuming face-to-face teaching across the College.

Invariably, however, over the course of the year, there will be students who will be required to stay at home for a range of reasons, including:

- being identified as close contacts and therefore required to quarantine for 7 or 14 days in line with SA Health requirements.
- testing positive to COVID-19 and being required to isolate for ten days in line with SA Health requirements.
- contracting illnesses limiting the ability to function at full capacity.

In the situations mentioned above, we ask that parents/caregivers inform the relevant Year Level Director (YLD) of their child's condition and the likely length of absence. The YLD will notify relevant teachers accordingly. The student will then be marked as either 'Absent' OR 'Working from Home', depending on the relevant scenario. Where a student recovers from the effects of their illness but is still required to complete the required isolation period, we ask that parents/caregivers update the YLD to change the student's status from 'Absent' to 'Working from Home.'

All schoolwork will be posted on the SEQTA Learning Management System to support student learning. Teachers will not be accessing remote learning via TEAMS for absent students whilst face-to-face delivery is occurring. Students are encouraged to email their teachers directly if further clarification or discussion around learning is required.

The College Counsellors are also on hand to support any of our students whose wellbeing is compromised by the impact of a compulsory extended absence from school.
