As the year draws to a close, it is that time in the school calendar when the College eagerly awaits the annual release of the South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE) results and the associated Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank (ATAR). St Michael's takes great pride in all its students' achievements; some will utilise their ATAR to apply for tertiary study, others will begin apprenticeships, a few will venture into the workforce, and a few more will take a "gap" year to consider options. It is important to remember that an ATAR score does not define a person or their future successes, and many tertiary institutions will look beyond this data to determine the suitability of the individual for the course chosen, taking into consideration portfolios of work, auditions, tests or similar.
